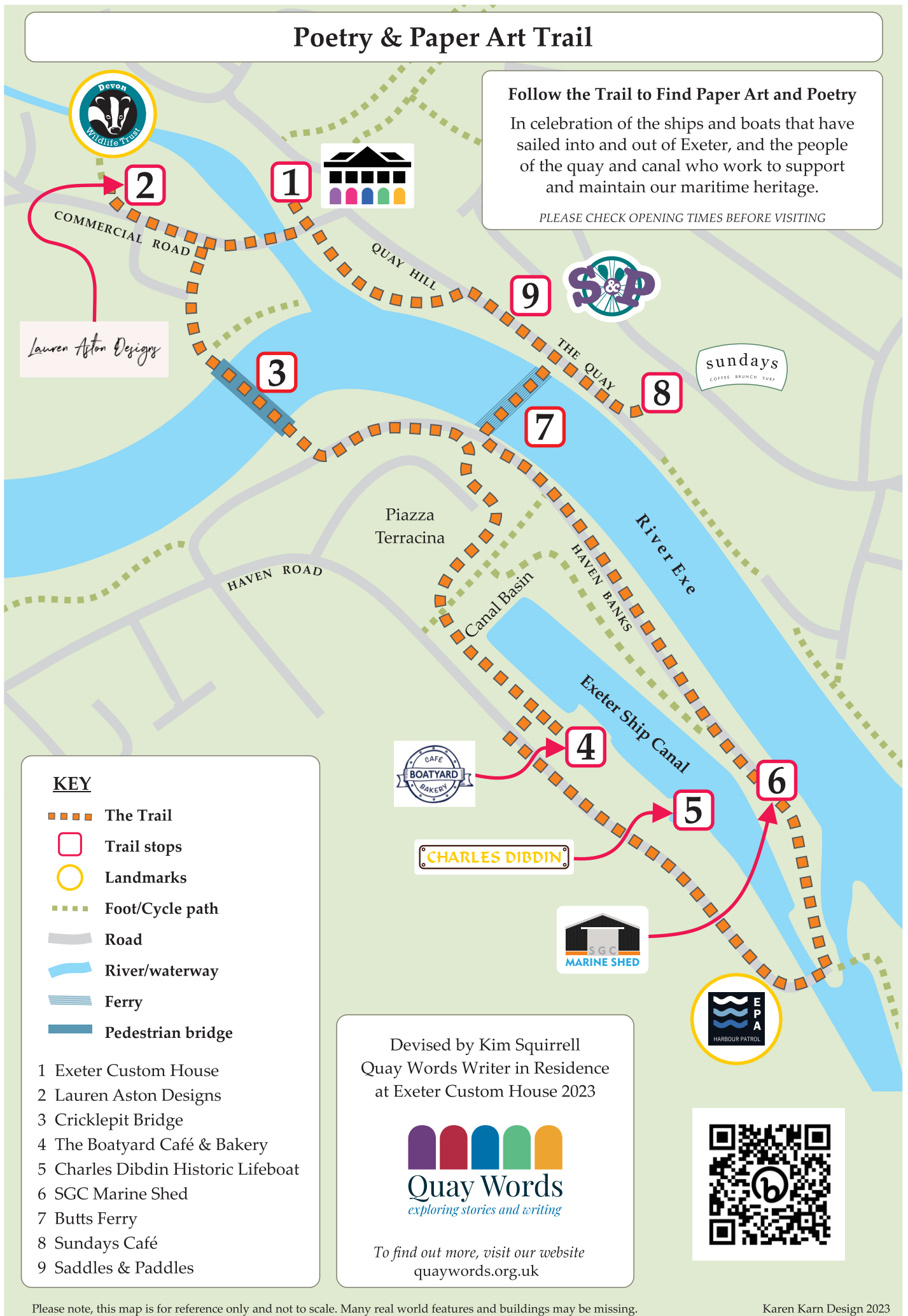


Poetry & Paper Art Trail

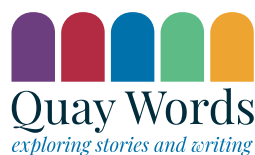
